



Canteen service: internal rules

- 1) The main purpose of the canteen service is to offer children balanced and varied meals.
- 2) The supervision of children is structured so that the children can recover from the efforts of the school mornings.
- 3) Children who do not respect the meals or the hygiene measures, lose the right to their lunch. Children who do not adhere to these rules (do not throw food on the floor or on friends, do not spit on the food or other misdeeds) lose the right to continue eating in the restaurant. (see also point 6))
- 4) To register, you must first register your child on our website (www.paiperlek.lu). After registration you can register your child for the required days.
- 5) All children attending the canteen service, must, for reasons of safety and insurance, remain on the premises. Children who leave the premises without explicit permission from staff may be excluded from the SEA Päiperlék.
- 6) All children are to be respectful and polite (Hello, please, thank you, goodbye). In case of regular negligence of these forms, or in case of insults against the staff, the parents/guardians must present themselves with their child for a meeting. In cases of non adherence to these rules, children may be excluded from the SEA Päiperlék.
- 7) In case the invoices are not paid, and after receiving an invoice reminder, the SEA will give a formal notice and the children will be excluded from the respective SEA.
- 8) For any additional questions and information, the staff or management remain at your disposal.
- 9) The measures provided in points 3; 5; 6 and 7 are undertaken by the managers.
- 10) In the event of any complaints against these decisions, you have the possibility to write to the management committee of the Lënster Päiperlék asbl.
