

Internal Order Rules (ROI) for the "Covid-19" period

Dear parents / guardians, the reopening of the day care facilities under the health constraints of the "Covid-19" pandemic poses a challenge for all of us. In addition to the typical rules of good conduct within the day care structures, we would like to bring you <u>a series of new rules</u> which apply imperatively between May 25th and July 15th (the date may vary depending on ministerial decisions):

- Children are required to either wash their hands or disinfect their hands at least once an hour.
- Children are required to wash their hands thoroughly after visiting the toilet.
- Children are required to stay in their room, unless the educators decide otherwise.
- Children are required to wear their mask outside their group room. In the room, wearing a mask is optional.
- Wearing a mandatory mask does not apply to children under the age of 6 years.
- Parents / guardians are not allowed to enter the the day care buildings. To organize the childrens pick up situation, our structure installs a reception at the entrance of the buildings.
- In general, we ask you to be aware of and apply the instructions from the Ministry and the

In view of the special situation, it remains to specify some essential service changes during school weeks according to registration:

- The day care no longer provides any supervision between 7:00 and 8:00 in the morning.
- The day care ensures telephone availability from 10:00 to 18:00.
- The day care takes care of your children between 13:00 and 18:00 during the school holidays according to registration.

Finally, the ASBL Lënster Päiperlék would like to recall some principles of good conduct that still apply within our structures:

- All children are required to respect the usual courtesy forms (Moien, wann ech gelift, thank you, äddi).
- Children are expected to respect other children, SEA staff and premises.
- All children are required to keep their electronic tools (Cell phones, Smartphones, Consoles, etc.) in their bag during their stay at the SEA.
